During the financial period, a total of 75,000 ordinary shares were allotted pursuant to the exercise of share options granted under the Boardroom Share Option Scheme. This gave rise to an increase in the Company's share capital from \$31,794,393.75 as at 30 June 2006 to \$31,821,718.75 as at 30 September 2006.

As at 30 September 2006, there were 3,022,000 (as at 30 September 2005: 5,119,000) unissued ordinary shares under exercisable options granted and unexercised under the Boardroom Share Option Scheme.

Revenue

Compared to the same period last year, fees increased by only 0.9% to \$7.1 million. The increase was due to a net increase in number of clients. However, the increase was offset by decreased fees from Corporate Secretarial business due mainly to keen competition, pricing pressure and the strengthening of Singapore dollar.

Other Income

Other income increased by 68.0% due to increased interest earned from our fixed deposits placed with banks because of higher interest rates.

Staff Costs

Staff costs increased by 7.8% due mainly to a one-off ex-gratia payment of \$198,150 paid to our former Chief Executive Officer in September 2006 upon his resignation.

Operating Expenses

Operating expenses increased by 40.7% due mainly to a write-back of provision for bad and doubtful debts of \$174,000 in 1Q06 against a provisioning charge of \$79,000 in 1Q07.

Loss on Foreign Exchange

The foreign currency translation loss of \$124,000 in 1Q07 was due to the strengthening of the Singapore dollar against the Hong Kong dollar and Malaysian Ringgit on amounts owing by our Hong Kong and Malaysian subsidiaries to the Company.

Income derived from Associated Company

No income was derived from associated company in 1Q07 against an income of \$186,000 in 1Q06 was due to our disposal of the entire 35% equity interest in Talent Shanghai Inc., Ltd in May 2006.

Income Tax

Income tax decreased by 23.5% due mainly to reduced profit.

Profit after Tax

Profit after tax decreased by 31.5%.

The Group's results are in line with its forecast statement made in the full year ended 30 June 2006 results released on 3 August 2006.

10. **A commentary at the date of the announcement of the significant trends and competitive conditions of the industry in which the group operates and any known factors or events that may affect the group in the next reporting period and the next 12 months.**

For the next reporting period and the next 12 months, the macro economic and business outlook in the Asia Pacific region is expected to remain encouraging. However, the Group continues to operate in a very competitive business environment. The year ahead will continue to be challenging as we envisage our operating costs are on an upward trend due to higher office rental costs, the relocation of our Singapore office in December 2006, staff costs resulting from the tight pool of qualified and experienced personnel and investment in new start-up investor relations business. Also, any further strengthening of the Singapore dollar will adversely affect the Group's result in the case of our overseas subsidiaries.

Notwithstanding this, management continues to strive for revenue growth through fresh business initiatives whilst maintaining prudent cost control measures.
