Revenue

Group revenue for the three months ended 31 March 2009 (3Q09) was \$8.8 million, a decrease of 2.0% compared to the same period in the previous year. Likewise, revenue for the nine months ended 31 March 2009 (9M09) decreased by 3.9% to \$25.9million.

A decline in the level of corporate activity by the Group's clients collectively resulted in a decrease in revenue across all business segments, with the exception of Accounting services, which registered an increase of 6.9% and 1.4% for 3Q09 and 9M09 respectively.

Other Income

Other income declined 27.3% and 19.0% for 3Q09 and 9M09, compared to their respective corresponding periods a year ago. This was largely due to lower interest rates received for our fixed deposits.

Staff Cost

Overall staff cost decreased 6.8% and 1.8% for 3Q09 and 9M09, compared to their respective corresponding periods a year ago. The cost reduction in 3Q09 was partly due to better utilization of our manpower resources and the Jobs Credit Scheme, a Singapore Government initiative introduced in the first quarter of 2009, which helped to subsidize part of the Group's staff cost.

Operating expenses

Operating expenses for 3Q09 registered a marginal increase of 1.4% to \$1.53 million compared to 3Q08. This was due mainly to higher rental charges. However, the increase was mitigated by a write-back of \$9,000 in provision for bad and doubtful debts in 3Q09 (as compared to a provision charge of \$29,000 in 3Q08).

Overall operating expenses for 9M09 increased by 7.4% compared to 9M08 due to higher rental charges resulting from the relocation of the Group's overseas offices towards the end of 2007.

Depreciation and Amortisation

The depreciation and amortisation charges for 3Q09 showed a marginal increase of 1.0% over 3Q08. However, depreciation and amortisation charges for 9M09 rose 14.2% over 9M08 due to higher depreciation charges on office leasehold improvements resulting from the relocation of the Group's overseas offices in 2007.

Foreign Exchange

The foreign exchange translation gain was due to the appreciation of Hong Kong dollar and Malaysian ringgit against the Singapore dollar.

Associated Company

Our share of associated company results of \$122,000 in 3Q09 and \$680,000 in 9M09, was attributed to our share of post-acquisition profits from Newreg Pty Limited, our Australia-based associated company.

Income Tax

The Group's income tax registered an increase of 11.9% for 3Q09 due to an under-provision of \$35,000 in the prior year for Singapore and Malaysia. However, 9M09 showed a decrease of 21.8% compared to 9M08, mainly due to the effect of tax under-provision for the Group's Hong Kong subsidiary in 2007 fiscal year, and the recent Government stimulus initiative to reduce company income tax rates for the current calendar year of 2009.

Profit after tax

In view of the above, the Group registered a 3.2% decline in profit after tax to \$6.7 million for 9M09. On the other hand, Group profit after tax increased 10.9% for 3Q09 to \$2.3 million, compared to 3Q08.

Intangible Assets

The increase in intangible assets resulted from foreign exchange translation gain arising from the appreciation of the Hong Kong dollar and Malaysian ringgit against the Singapore dollar.

Business environment is expected to remain weak for the rest of the financial year regionally.

Consequently, the level of corporate activity initiated by the Group's clients is expected to remain low, and the number of Initial Public Offerings (IPO) is not likely to pick up during the year.

Competition will continue to be strife, with continued pricing pressure coming from second-tier service providers.

Costs are not expected to reduce significantly due to committed fixed overheads. However, recently introduced business stimulus initiatives by the Singapore Government should provide some relief going forward.

The Group's investment in Australia-based associated company, Newreg Pty Limited is also expected to provide a positive revenue stream for the Group in the current financial year.

The Group will continue to be vigilant in cost control and cautiously expects the rest of the financial year to be profitable.
